**Air Hygiene Vs. MRSA, Clostridium difficile etc.**

"...we have had no case of MRSA in six years and 2,000+ patients. So the risk of infection remains, but the French infection control policy is rigidly adhered to and operated: this includes a locker policy for staff clothing, directly employing cleaners who work with the nurses, e.g. surface wiping before dressing changes, no air conditioning in the individual rooms, mobile laminar flow, patient swabbing before admission, and much more..."
